

Scholarship Application Requirements

Music Theatre of Wenatchee is pleased to offer scholarship opportunities to any graduating senior or recent high school graduate from Chelan and Douglas County or Quincy, who is entering their first year at an accredited post-secondary institution, and has demonstrated excellence, involvement, and leadership in the performing arts. Preference may be given to students who have been (or whose parents have been) involved with MTW.

All applications with accompanying materials must be submitted through this online application form no later than April 15, 2025, at 11:59pm PDT. (Please note that incomplete applications or materials submitted via mail will not be considered.)

Scholarship award recipients will be announced at the Apple Awards in May. Scholarship funds will be sent by check directly to the post-secondary institution of the recipient's choice.

Eligibility:

- U.S. citizen or permanent U.S. resident
- Graduating senior or recent high school graduate from Chelan/Douglas County or Quincy
- Entering your first year as an undergraduate at an accredited post-secondary institution, college, or university
- Have a minimum 3.0 GPA on a 4.0 scale (cumulative)
- Demonstrate involvement, leadership, and excellence in performing arts activities

Application Requirements:

- Completed online Application Form with the following attachments in pdf format (except the photo, which may be any image file format):
 - Resume detailing your performing arts activities and awards (you may also include academics, other extracurricular activities, employment, and/or community service, if desired)
 - 2. A thoughtfully written **personal essay** describing how the performing arts have impacted you thus far, and how they will continue to impact you in the future through your educational and personal goals and involvement in your community
 - 3. **Three (3) letters of recommendation**: two (2) from teachers and/or coaches, and one (1) from a person who is a personal reference, all of whom can speak to your performing arts experience and abilities, and the impact you have had on your school and/or community through the performing arts
 - 4. Copy of current school transcript
 - 5. Recent **photograph** that is suitable for publication (if you are awarded an MTW Scholarship)
- Finalists must make themselves available for an interview at the request of the Scholarship Committee
