

Numerica Performing Arts Center: Policy on Covid-19

Beginning September 1st (2021), audience members will be required to be fully vaccinated or show proof of negative Covid-19 test for all performances and public events held indoors.

Masks are required to be worn at all times while not actively eating or drinking.

For Vaccination Card Proof (Individuals over the age of 12)

The Numerica Performing Arts Center will require:

- Proof of COVID-19 vaccination
- Fully vaccinated means that your final vaccination was more than 14 days prior to the date of your performance or event.
- The following are acceptable as proof of full vaccination
 - Vaccination card (which includes name of person vaccinated, type of vaccine and date last dose administered).
 - A printed photo of the attendee's vaccination card.
 - A photo of the attendee's vaccination card stored on a phone or electronic device.
 - Documentation of vaccination from a healthcare provider, electronic health record or state Immunization Information System record.

For Negative Covid-19 Test Proof

The Numerica Performing Arts Center will require:

- Proof of a negative COVID-19 test
 - Proof of a negative COVID-19 PCR test taken within 72 hours of the performance start time, or
 - Proof of a negative COVID-19 antigen test taken within 12 hours of the performance start time.
- The following are acceptable as proof of a negative COVID-19 test result
 - Printed document, email, or text message displayed on a phone or electronic device from the test provider or laboratory that includes:
 - the name of person tested
 - type of test performed
 - the date of negative test result.

Self-reported negative test results that are not from a test provider, a laboratory or a health care provider cannot be accepted.
